B. Discussion – 3220 Majestic View – Tree Trimming - \$700

On a MOTION by Mr. Cornelius, SECONDED by Ms. Medina, WITH Mr. Vide and Mr. Ramos voting AYE and Mr. Campbell voting NAY, the Board approved the proposal for \$700 to trim tree at 3220 Majestic View for the Stonebrier Community Development District.

On a MOTION by Mr. Vide, SECONDED by Ms. Medina, WITH ALL IN FAVOR, the Board agreed to replace the bridge lights and any necessary outlets for an amount not to exceed \$1,500 for the Stonebrier Community Development District.
